



Pallet Recycling Policy

Effective Date: 1st June 2023

Policy Statement:

At Airwave, we are committed to environmental sustainability and responsible waste management practices. As part of our efforts, we have implemented a pallet recycling program to reduce promote the reuse of pallets. within our organisation. This policy outlines the procedures and guidelines for pallet recycling at Airwave.

Scope:

This policy applies to all employees and departments within Airwave who handle pallets.

Policy Guidelines:

Pallet Recycling Process:
