



Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Compliance Policy

Effective Date: 1st June 2023

Policy Statement:

At Airwave, we are committed to environmental sustainability and responsible waste management practices, particularly when it comes to the disposal of Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE). This policy outlines our commitment to comply with WEEE regulations and guidelines by ensuring that all WEEE waste is properly disposed of using registered and authorised recycling companies.

Scope:

This policy applies to all employees and departments within Airwave who handle electrical and electronic equipment and are involved in its disposal.

Policy Guidelines:

WEEE Waste Disposal:

- b. Prioritise partnerships with recycling companies that have proven expertise in environmentally responsible WEEE waste management.

Compliance with Regulations:

- a. Stay informed and up-to-date with relevant WEEE regulations, guidelines, and legislation applicable to Airwave's operations.
- b. Regularly review and assess the compliance of our WEEE waste management practices with the latest regulations and make necessary adjustments as required.

Employee Awareness and Training:

- a. Provide employees with clear guidelines on the identification, handling, and disposal of WEEE waste.
- b. Offer training and awareness programs to ensure that employees are familiar with WEEE regulations and understand their responsibilities in proper waste disposal.
